Our Scripture readings for this week hint at just this way of doing things. In *Acts 1:15-17, 21-26* the once confrontational Peter must choose a new disciple to take the place of Judas Iscariot. He asks God to choose the one with the heart that will best serve Him.

Psalm 1 is a poem that warns readers they will meet others who do not believe in God. Sometimes their arguments will test the faith of believers. But using the turnabout logic, the psalmist asks a simple question of the scoffers. Well, if not God, on what do you base your life? This leaves the scoffers with no basis for their life beyond their opinions. And we all know opinions change over time. That brings me back to where I started. We will be confused this summer by news reports, internet rumors, and odd opinions coming from people we never thought would say such things. Some of those ideas may test your faith. Just remember that there is one, permanent source of all things, and ideas, Who has a plan for all of this.
